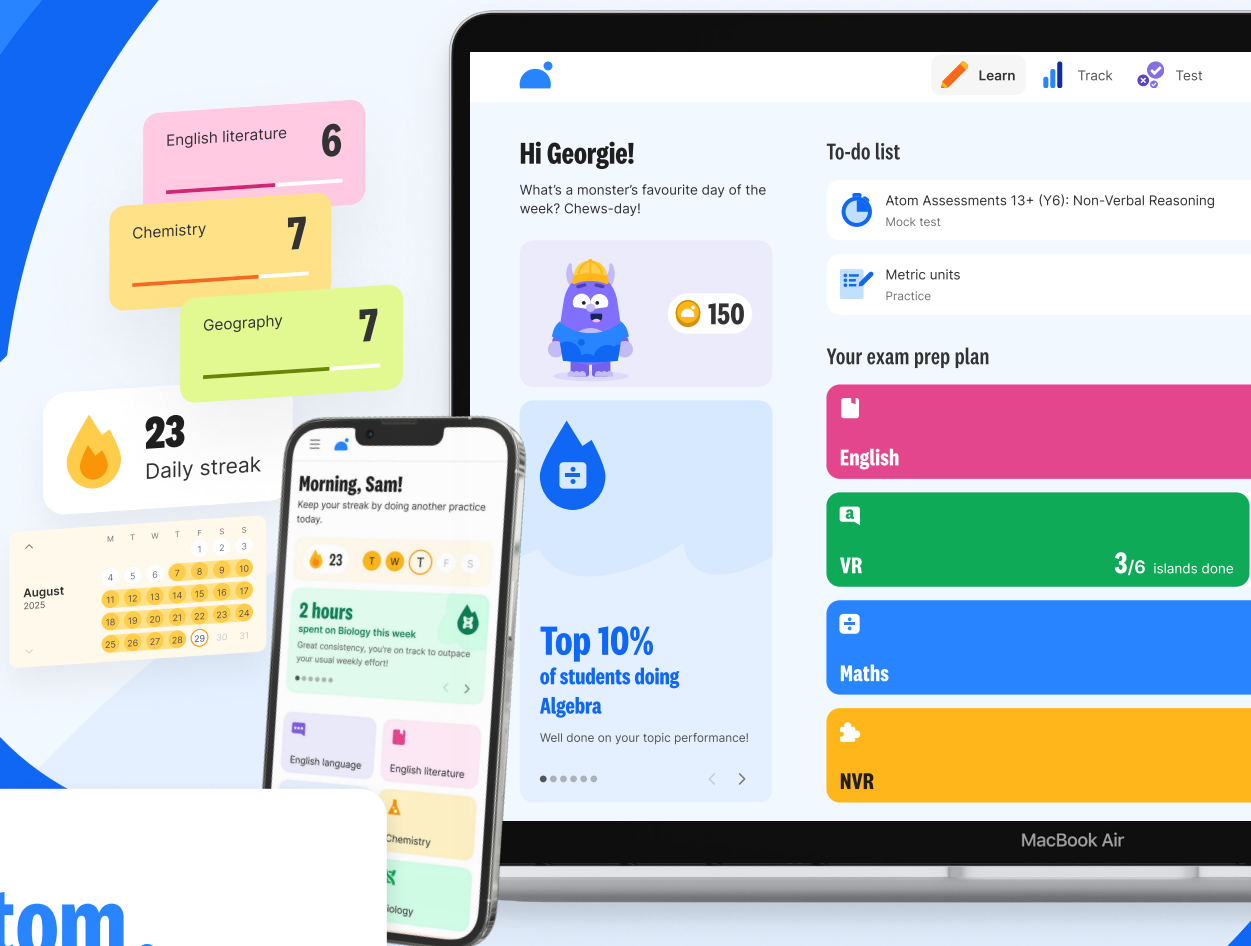

What is Atom Access?

Closing the attainment gap starts with closing the access gap.

Atom Access gives every pupil eligible for pupil premium full access to Atom, free.

For pupils in Years 3 to 6:

- Personalised Key Stage 2 learning, Year 6 SATs support and 11+ preparation (normally £575.90 per year).

For students in Years 9 to 11:

- Structured, exam-board-specific GCSE learning and revision support (normally £575.90 per year).

What is Atom Learning?

Atom Learning is the UK's leading online learning and exam preparation platform, trusted by over 350,000 families. At the heart of our work is a commitment to making high-quality learning accessible to all, supporting schools in narrowing the attainment gap.

We have designed the programme to be as simple as possible for schools and families, reducing barriers to access.



For primary schools

Every child eligible for pupil premium, not just those considering grammar school, gets the full Atom Home platform, free (normally £575.90 per year).

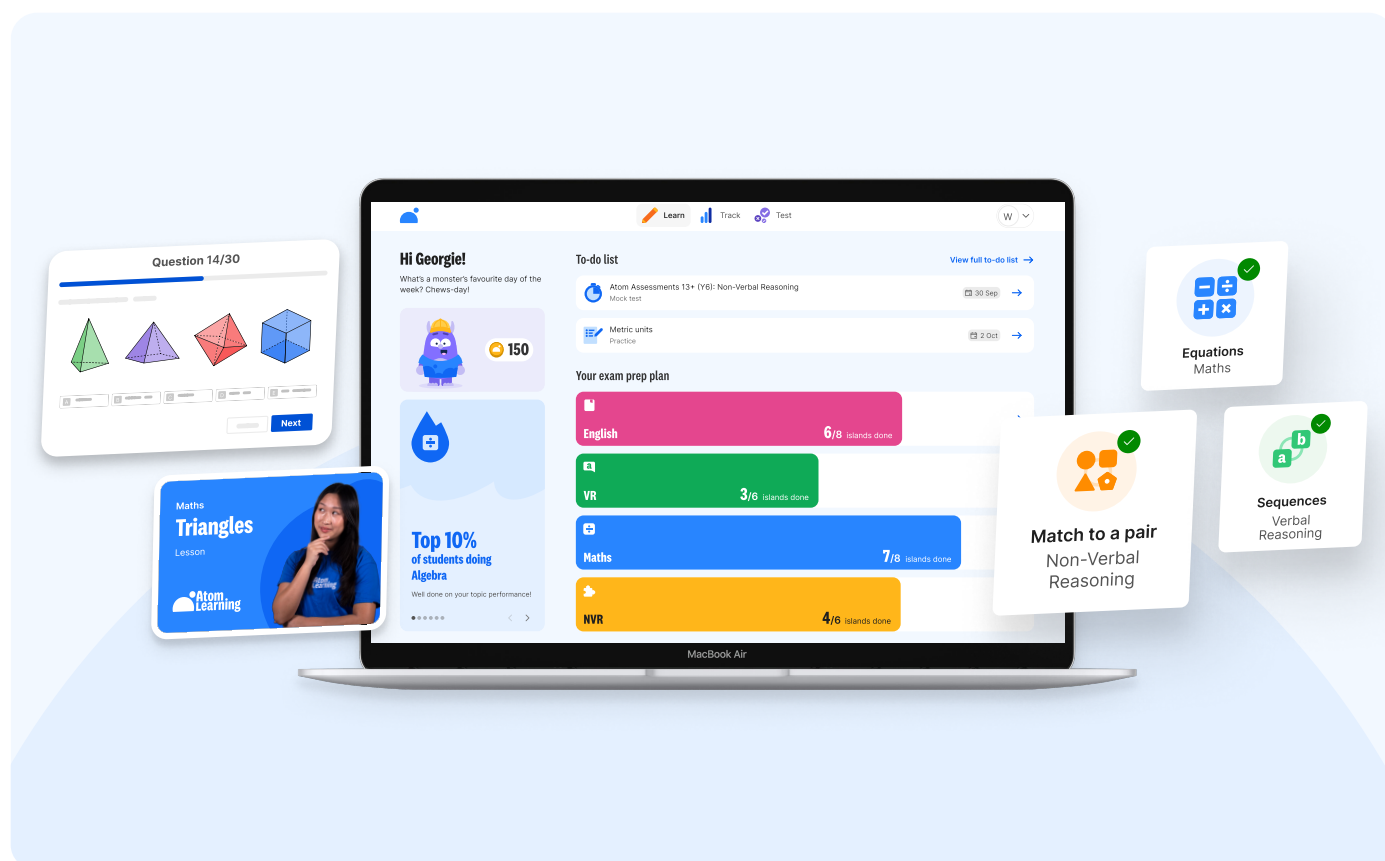
What is Atom Home?

Atom Home is an online learning and exam preparation platform for children aged 7 to 11. It is built around national curriculum frameworks, with additional material for reasoning.

Atom Home gives children access to:

- Adaptive questions across KS2 English, maths and science, in addition to verbal and non-verbal reasoning
- Learning resources and video tutorials
- Engaging, interactive challenges and puzzles
- Practice papers and mock tests for Year 6 SATs and 11+ entry assessments

Atom Home is designed to build children's confidence with Key Stage 2 learning objectives and, where relevant, improve exam technique by familiarising them with 11+ style questions. It is an engaging, child-centric platform, built to increase motivation and enjoyment of learning.



For secondary schools

Every child eligible for pupil premium in Years 9-11 gets the full Atom GCSE platform, free (normally £575.90 per year).

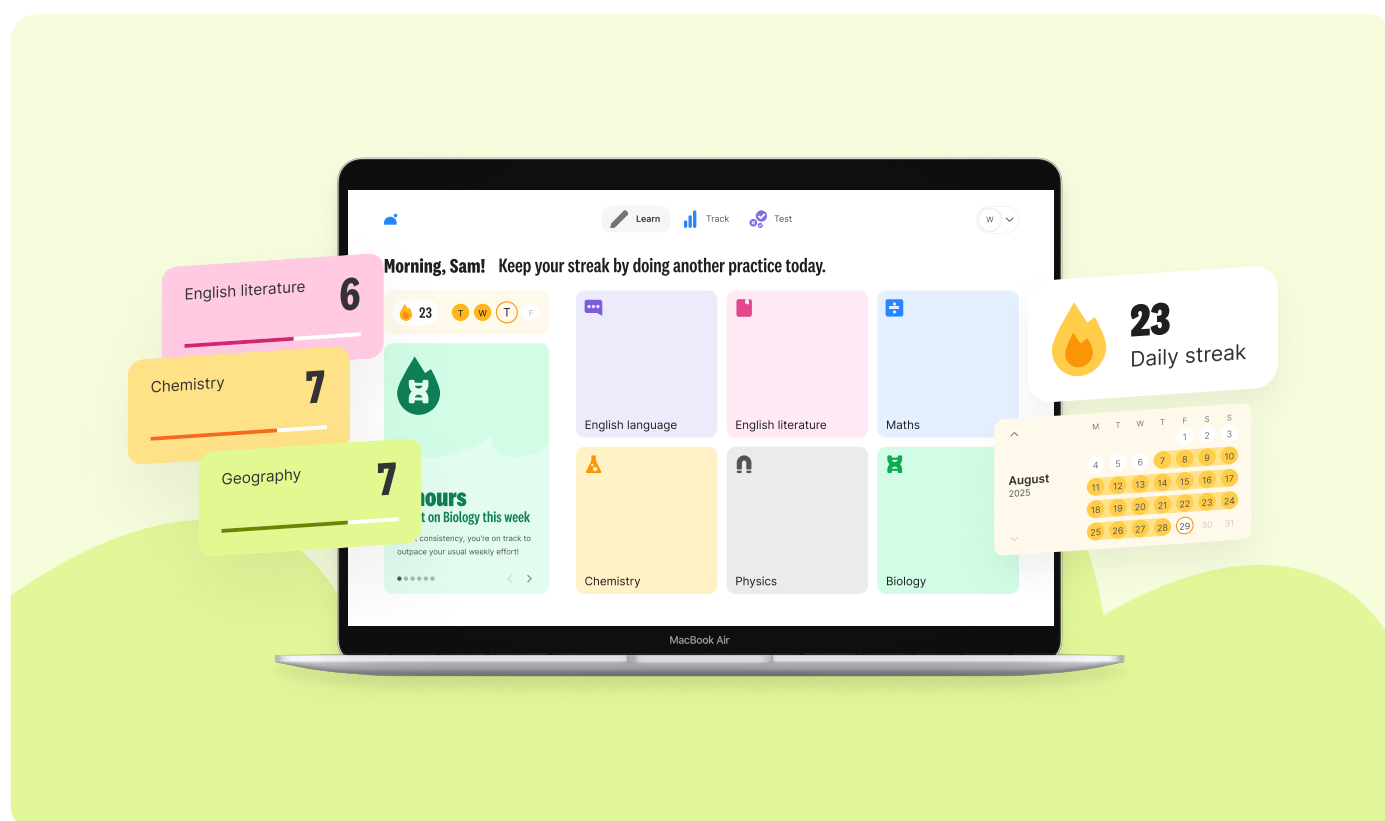
What is Atom GCSE?

Atom GCSE is an online revision platform for students aged 14–16. It brings everything they need for GCSE success into one place.

Atom GCSE gives students access to:

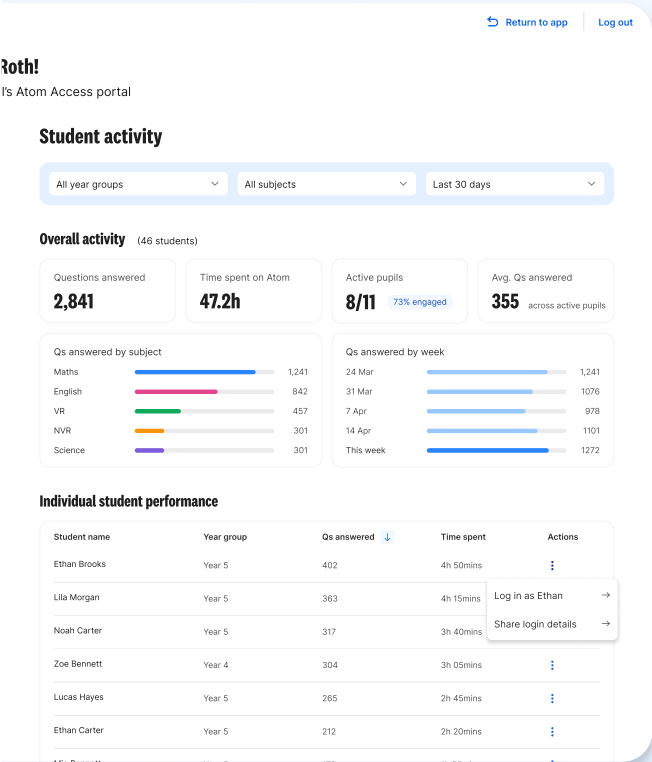
- **Exam-board-specific practice:** GCSE-style questions, past papers and predicted papers matched to each student's exam board.
- **Instant feedback:** AI marking based on real GCSE mark schemes.
- **Clear explanations:** Step-by-step guidance on how to improve.
- **Progress tracking:** Predicted grades and topic insights showing what to revise next.
- **Structured revision:** Simple, manageable courses that help students stay organised.

Atom GCSE Pro is designed to build students' confidence with the GCSE curriculum, helping them understand exactly where to focus their time, stay motivated and make measurable progress.



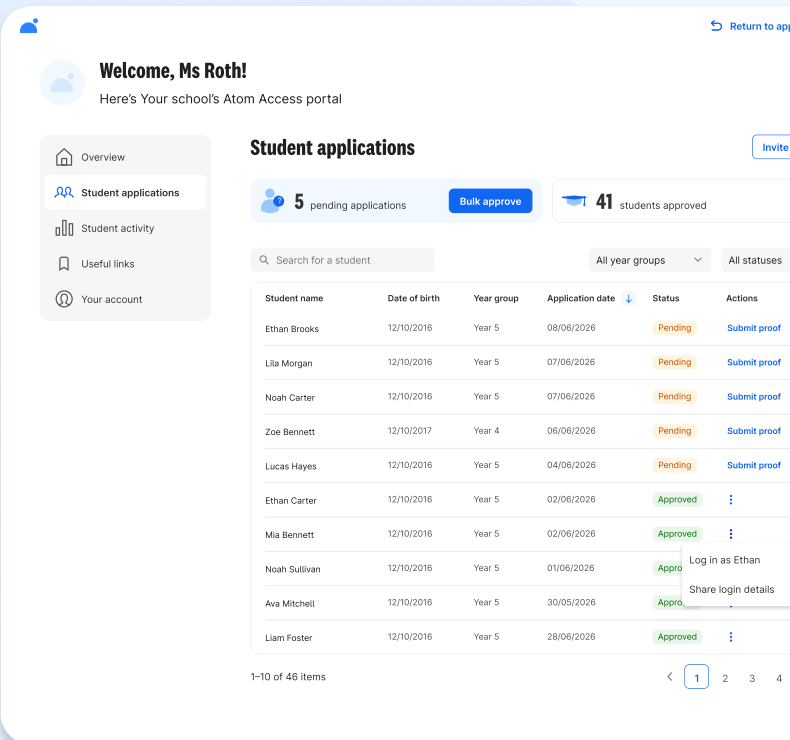
Your Atom Access dashboard

As part of Atom Access, you'll have access to a dedicated teacher dashboard that keeps everything in one place and gives you a clear view of how pupils are using their accounts.



- From the 'Student activity' page, you can track each pupil's engagement and progress, helping you understand the impact of the support and gather clear evidence for your pupil premium strategy statement.

- From the 'Student applications' page, you can manage applications from your pupil premium students, verify eligibility and see who is accessing a free account, as well as who has not yet signed up.



Why we created Atom Access

We created Atom Access with a clear mission: to close the attainment gap by closing the access gap.

The gap between under-resourced pupils and their peers remains stubborn. It stands at around 10 months by the end of primary school and widens to 19.1 months by the end of secondary school.

That's why we created Atom Access: to give the children who need it most free access to high-quality, personalised learning. Atom meets each child where they are, identifies gaps in their learning and helps them make progress step by step. Every child learns differently, and every child deserves support that reflects that.

Since launching in early 2024, we have supported more than 15,000 eligible pupils and partnered with over 3,500 UK schools. But we want to go further. Our ambition is that every eligible child in the UK gets the full Atom platform, free, so they can fulfil their potential and access opportunities that might otherwise feel out of reach.



How do students access the support?

1. Join the Atom Access programme [via this page](#).
2. We'll set up your teacher dashboard and provide a letter to share with eligible families. We can also arrange a short call to answer any questions and help you get started.
3. Upload your list of eligible pupils through the dashboard, and we'll create an Atom account for each one.
